

Stave 4 Writing Activity: An Alternate Reality for Scrooge



In this chapter, we see a very dim future for Scrooge. The Ghost of Christmas Yet to Come shows him the kind of life he will have if he continues on the path he has been on.

But wait—Scrooge has vowed to change, hasn't he? If Scrooge changes his ways, he might have a very different kind of future.

Directions: You are going to use your descriptive writing skills to describe Scrooge's life once he reforms. Focus on these three categories, and be sure to use LOTS of description. Each paragraph should be at least 5 sentences long.

Paragraph 1: Work

How will Scrooge's attitude toward work change? How will his workplace change? How will he treat his employees or customers differently?

Base your content on specific evidence from the book. For example: Scrooge never had a large fire. You could say that he changes this by always keeping a sparkling warm fire going all winter long.

Paragraph 2: Home

Think about what Scrooge's home life was like. How will it change? Again, use a lot of detail and be very specific.

Paragraph 3: Relationships

Although Scrooge seems like a lonely old man, there are actually quite a few people in his life. How will his interactions with them change? Will he get new people? Use a lot of detail and be specific.
