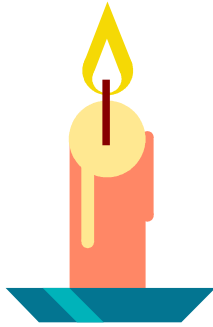


Victorian Holiday Party



Get your time machine warmed up! In groups of 3-4, you are going to become a Victorian party planner. You must include three of these four categories.

Victorian Food

Choose and supply Victorian-inspired holiday food. You may either buy or bake the goodies for the class. Remember that the party will occur during your regular English class, so keep in mind the time of day. You must include food and drink, as well as utensils and cups, forks, and so on. Be creative!

Victorian Games

Do a quick Google search for VICTORIAN PARLOR GAMES and you will get lots of suggestions. Look in Stave 3 of *A Christmas Carol* for ideas. Either write out the instructions as a script or make instruction cards for you guests. Be sure you bring any needed materials. You may also choose Victorian card games.

You can choose a Victorian-era craft and bring the supplies and make instruction sheets. Crafts should take no more than 10 minutes. Make sure you have all the needed materials!

Victorian Music

You must supply entertainment! Your choices are: Choose a Victorian-era piece of music and play it yourself or play a recording, choose a Victorian-era carol and entertain us by singing it as a group (or choose one person to sing), or lead the class in a sing-along of at least one Victorian-era carol. Be sure to bring lyrics for your classmates to read.
