Choose ONE of the following projects to complete for F. Scott Fitzgerald's *The Great Gatsby*. Although you are completing this project individually, feel free to recruit help and ask suggestions of your group members. You will need to provide all of your own materials for this project and to complete the majority of it on your own time. This project is due

Wild Rumors

Gatsby's past is shrouded in wild rumors. Write a flashback chapter that brings one or more of these rumors to life that would fit somewhere within *The Great Gatsby*.

Descriptive Map

The characters of the novel often travel from East and West Egg (Great Neck and Little Neck) to Manhattan. Create a map of this area and trace the paths of the events of this story.

New Book Cover

Design a new book cover for the novel that depicts what

you feel are the dominant images, scenes and events of the book. Write a short explanation of the elements you picked and why you picked them.

Gatsby's Eulogy

Few people attended Gatsby's funeral and just as few people seem to know much about him that is factual. Write a eulogy that Nick could have delivered at Gatsby's funeral.

Graphic Novel

Select a particularly vivid scene from the novel (maybe Gatsby's murder, or Myrtle's death, or the drive through the valley of ashes) and re-tell

it in the form of a graphic novel (comic book).

Advice for Daisy

Writing as Daisy, send a letter to an advice columnist

explaining your problems. Try to capture her tone as you write. Then, writing as the columnist, answer the letter, suggesting a course of action Daisy might take.
