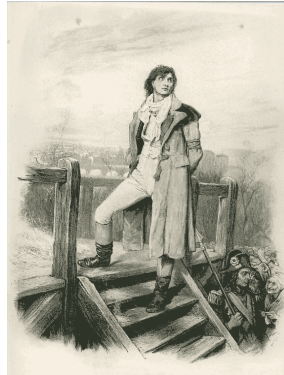


***A Tale of Two Cities* Reader's Theater Review**

Directions: Choose a group of 2-3 people. As a group, decide which scene from the book you want to act out. Do not limit yourselves to same-gender roles! You can also eliminate non-essential characters from the scene by just pretending that they are there.

1. **Choose an important scene:** Choose a scene from anywhere in the book that you think is important to the plot. You can choose any scene, as long as no other group is performing it.
2. **The scene must be 5-10 minutes:** When acted out, your scene should be no longer than 10 minutes and not less than 5 minutes.
3. **Make a script:** Use an excerpt of the book to make a script for your group. The script needs to contain stage directions and dialogue as it is written in the book.
4. **Find costumes and props:** Each person must have a costume and a prop. The scene must also have appropriate props.
5. **Rehearse the scene:** Rehearse the scene. Actors don't have to memorize the lines, but doing so will make your scene better. Extra credit will be granted to those who memorize.
6. **Perform the scene:** You will perform the scene for your classmates to help review the book.

You will be graded on:

- Choice of scene
- Costumes and Props
- Acting (meaning gets across)
- Creativity
