

Extra Credit Options- You may choose ONE 50 point assignment, or 2 25 point assignments

1. Create a one-page newspaper article for an event in Things Fall Apart. (25 points)
2. Write the paragraph about Okonkwo that the District Commissioner will include in his book. (25 points)
3. The plot of the novel is guided by conflicts that affect Okonkwo's family & clan. Choose three different conflicts, one from each section of the novel. Write a well-organized essay explaining why Achebe includes each particular conflict, & its overall effect on the story. (50 points)
4. In Chapter 15, Uchendu says "The world has no end, & what is good among one people is an abomination among others."
 - a. Identify/Describe an Ibo practice that is good for their people, but is seen as an abomination by others.
 - b. Justify that practice in Ibo terms.
 - c. Identify/Describe a British or Christian practice that is good for their people, but seen as an abomination by the Ibo.
 - d. Justify that practice in British or Christian terms. (50 points)
5. For the following characters, identify:
 - a. His/her relation to Okonkwo
 - b. His/her thoughts of Okonkwo
 - c. Okonkwo's thoughts of him/her
 - d. What happened to him/her in the story (50 points)

 - Nwoye
 - Ekwefi
 - Ezinma
 - Obierika
6. Choose one character in the novel. Write a one-page journal entry describing an important event in the novel from that character's point of view. (25 points)
